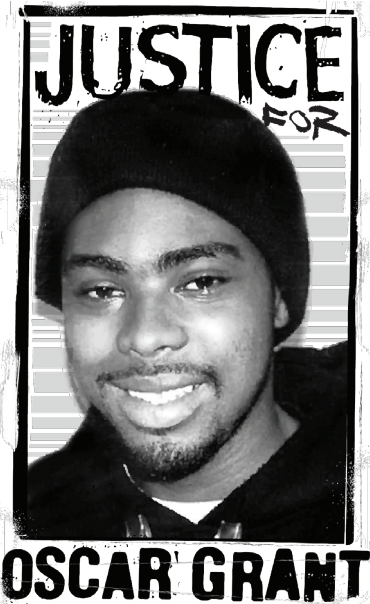
In the early morning hours of New Year's Day 2009, BART transit cops brutally executed an unarmed 22-year-old African father, Oscar Grant III.
